From Southern MI/Ohio:  
75 North to 275 North toward Flint  
M5 North (exit 165) toward Grand River Ave./Port Huron  
Stay on M5 North (merges left). It dead ends at Pontiac Trail. Turn Right  
At first light (Haggerty Road) turn Left  
Stay on Haggerty Road until it dead ends at Richardson Road. Turn left.  
Immediate traffic light - Turn Right (Union Lake Road)  
Take Union Lake Road nearly 2 miles to Wise Rd. Turn Left (only direction)  
Take Wise Road about 2 miles to Bogie Lake Road. Turn right.  
School is 1 mile down on the left. Turn left into campus. Stay Left

From Western MI:  
I 96 East, Get off at exit 159 (Wixom)  
Turn Left onto Wixom Road go about 4 miles to Glengary Road  
Turn right onto Glengary Road and go about 2 miles  
Turn left onto Benstein Road and go about 2 miles until it dead ends  
Turn right onto Sleeth Road about 1/2 mile.  
Turn left onto N. Commerce Road (N.Commerce becomes Bogie Lake Rd.)  
School is 1.5 miles down on the left. Turn left into the campus. Stay left

1. Entry Deadline for Pageant entries: APRIL 16, 2010 (No late entries; No phone entries for Pageant events - money must accompany entry).

3. Late entries accepted for open events only. Late fee: 3.00/event, \$4.00/event day of contest (No checks accepted day of contest)
4. Food will be available all day. No outside food allowed in building.
5. Doors open at 8:00; drawing at 8:30, competition begins at 9:00
6. Order for Basic Skills, Beg. & Int. pageants will be alphabetical starting with "F" for model, 1/3 down for strut, 2/3 down for solo.
7. Order for Advanced pageants will be determined by draw at 8:30.
8. No "shuffling" of performance order for pageant events is allowed.  
Every effort will be made so that open events will go on before pageant events, but cannot be guaranteed.
9. Building owner, contest director and sponsors are not responsible for accidents, injuries or property damage or loss.

For open events, a system of flexible awards will be used and awards will be presented at awards table following conclusion of each event. Announcement of all pageant results will follow completion of competition.

## INDIVIDUAL EVENTS

Age Divisions for all events: 0-6, 7-9, 10-12, 13-15, 16+  
(Competition age is determined by contestant's age on Sept. 1, 2009)

### MISS MAJORETTE OF MICHIGAN (Michigan residents only)

- 3 part competition; twirlers must participate in all 3 to be eligible for placement.
- A. Modeling with Interview - circle "T" pattern  
Contestants wear dresses (0-6, 7-9 must be short dresses). Max. 1:00 for modeling; interview follows immediately after judge has completed scoring
  - B. Super X Strut - Time Limit: 1:30 - 2:00 Super X pattern
  - C. Solo  
Time Limit 2:20-2:30; No gymnastics allowed. College contestants perform a minimum of 1:10 with 1 baton; remainder may be multiple or novelty batons.

### BEGINNER & INTERMEDIATE PAGEANTS (Mich. residents only)

- 3 part competition; Contestants must participate in all 3 parts to be eligible for placement. Solo twirl status determines division to enter.
- A. Best Appearing with Interview - circle "T" pattern  
Contestants wear costumes and must wear modeling costume for either solo or strut, as well. Max. 1:00 for modeling; interview follows immediately after judge has completed modeling score.
  - B. Super X Strut - Time Limit: 1:30 - 2:00 Super X pattern
  - C. Solo  
Time Limit varies with solo twirling level. NO GYMNASTICS allowed.

### BASIC SKILLS PAGEANT (Michigan residents only)

- 3 part competition: Contestants must participate in all 3 parts to be eligible for placement. Open to Special Beginner and Novice twirlers ONLY.
- A. Best Appearing - In Costume - Circle "T" pattern, Max. 1:00; No Interview
  - B. Basic March - marching in a square
  - C. Solo - time limit :30 -2:00

**Modeling** (in dresses; no interview): Beginner, Intermediate, Adv.  
**Best Appearing** (in costume, no baton): Beginner, Intermed., Adv.  
**Basic March** (marching in a square): Beginner and Advanced  
**Super X Strut**: Novice, Beginner, Intermediate, Advanced  
**Special Beginner Solo**: Never won first place in solo (time :30-2:00)  
**Solo**: Novice (Time :30-2:00), Beginner (time 1:30-2:00),  
Intermediate (Time: 1:50-2:10), Advanced (Time: 2:20-2:30)  
**College Solo**: (Time: 2:20 -2:30, 1 baton min. of 1:10)  
**Visitors Solo (non-Michigan residents)**: Beginner, Inter., Advanced  
**Visitors X Strut (non-Michigan residents)**: Beginner, Inter., Adv.  
**2 Baton**: (Time 1:30 - 2:00) Beginner, Intermediate, Advanced  
**3 Baton**: (Time :30-2:00) One division only
